### ONGOING ATTRACTIONS

**TRINITY FOREST ADVENTURE PARK** Expect zip lines, cargo nets, bridges, climbing features and balance beams on the course at this Dallas attraction. Reservations are recommended. trinitytreetops.com.

**FORT WORTH ZOO** Attractions at the zoo, which features more than 7,000 animals, include Texas Wild with animals from the Lone Star State, a meerkat colony, and chances to see birds up close in Parrot Paradise. fortworthzoo.org.

**REUNION TOWER** The landmark's circular observation deck, at 470 feet, is a fabulous place to take out-of-town visitors to give them the lay of the land, or just to spend some time gazing out at the Trinity River, the lush greenness of Oak Cliff, the architectural peaks and valleys of downtown, and on a clear day, even AT&T Stadium in the distance. reuniontower.com.

**PINSTACK** The 50,000-square-foot venue in Plano features 28 bowling lanes, a ropes course, laser tag, bumper cars, rock-climbing walls, a full-service restaurant and more. pinstackbowl.com.
